It is for general information to all the newly admitted students of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester of Dr. MSIT, Haldia for the session 2020-21 that they can apply for the IOCL Gyanodaya Scholarship Scheme on fulfillment of following criteria:

- i) Annual family income of parents from all sources should be less than 2.5 lakhs. A certificate from competent authority (BDO, Joint BDO, SDO, Chief Executive Officer of Municipality/Corporation or Designated Government Officials) is essential for aspiring candidates.
- ii) For preparation of merit list; the filled in application form along with the self attested Xerox copies of madhyamik mark sheet, admit card, mark sheet and admit card of class XII (if the candidate is class XII passed). Aadhaar card, Clear and visible photo copy of Bank Account of the candidate, SC/ST. OBC. PC certificate are to be sent in a single PDF file.
- iii) Government reservation rules will be strictly followed for entitlement of scholarship.
- iv) A student is entitled to get one scholarship at a time. If the application of any student is processed/forwarded for others scholarship then the application for IOCL Gyanodaya scholarship will not be considered further.
